- ✓ Use a calendar daily (ex. due dates from syllabus, academic calendar, holidays, finals)
- ✓ Stick with their schedule. DO NOT drop/add classes without academic advisor approval.
- ✓ Attend class and purchase ALL class materials (books, access codes, supplies, etc.)
- ✓ Read/Follow syllabus & get to know their professors

- ✓ Be responsible (sleep, eat, and exercise!)
- ✓ Be respectful (roommate expectations/classroom conduct)
